Each child must bring his or her own youth lacrosse stick and 2 lacrosse balls (please print your last name on them).

New equipment can be purchased at Step-In Sports in downtown Chagrin. Used equipment can be purchased at Play It Again Sports in Lyndhurst (see the attached coupon). You should expect to pay about \$35 for a new stick and \$20 for a used one. At this point in your child's development, no one brand of stick is better or worse than any other.
